Ex-HMAS Canberra Dive Site – Removal of Mooring Buoys

Date: 16 May 2014 to 30 May 2014

Details: Mariners are advised of the removal of two of four mooring buoys located at the ex HMAS Canberra dive site.

The two mooring buoys are located at approximate location 38°17.959'S, 144°32.620'E and 38°17.970'S, 144°32.639'E (WGS84) and are yellow in colour with light characteristics **3Q.FL.Y.10s** 2M range.

The remaining two mooring buoys will be retained in their current position at approximate location 38°17.959'S, 144°32.620'E and 38°17.970'S, 144°32.639'E (WGS84).

Mariners are advised to navigate with caution when navigating within the vicinity of the works and the Ex-HMAS Canberra dive site special use zone.
